Safety Management – Safety Data Reporting in just Culture Environment



Safety management is only as effective as the culture which enables information to flow into it and impactful change to flow out of it.



ICAO Annex 19 highlights voluntary safety reporting systems as a critical component for a robust safety management system.

- Fostering a Safety Culture



By incorporating these elements, States and organizations can create a robust voluntary safety reporting program that not only enhances safety but also contributes to a positive safety culture.

- Management Commitment State Legislation
- Non-Punitive Reporting Environment
- Confidentiality
- Accessibility
- Awareness and Training
- Feedback Mechanism
- Analysis and Action
- Integration with Safety Management System
- Metrics and Evaluation

Governing Voluntary Reporting Programs CORE OPERATING PRINCIPLES



<u>Note</u>: Non-punitive does not mean blatant violations are not addressed; such as in the case of reports associated with criminal activity, substance abuse, controlled substances, alcohol, or intentional falsification.
