What is an RSOO?

Regional Safety Oversight Organization (RSOO)



An RSOO would be any regional or sub-regional safety oversight body that assists a group of States in meeting their safety oversight obligations or carries out safety related tasks and functions on behalf of a State or group of States, providing economies of scale by sharing resources within the region.



RSOOs include a number of legal forms and institutional structures that range from highly formalized intergovernmental organizations to less institutionalized projects.



ICAO Assembly Resolutions essentially leave it up to each group of States to determine the legal form and institutional structure that best fits the needs and characteristics of their specific region.



RSOOs





To help remove obstacles to effective oversight capability for individual States

Such obstacles can be due to:

- inadequate financial resources
- inadequate human resources
- low levels of aviation activity within a State
- competing demands for State resources
- new technology or industry entrants require expertise a State may not have available



Common objectives of RSOOs include:

prioritization of effective and efficient oversight

harmonization of safety regulations

pooling of human and financial resources

provide efficient services to State CAAs

identifying and supporting best practices within the region



RSOOs Scope of Activities

Examples of how RSOOs support States:



Provide technical assistance to Member States for effective safety oversight systems



Contribute to regional integration efforts by facilitating safe and efficient cross-border air travel which can lead to economic benefits;



Develop harmonized policies, regulations, guidance material, and procedures to attain safety targets;



Provide training programs and capacity-building initiatives;



Share best practices, expertise, and resources;



Examples of how RSOOs support States



Facilitate emergency response coordination;



Assist with the resolution of deficiencies identified;



Mutual recognition of approved maintenance organizations (AMO), approved training organizations (ATO) and medical examiner centers;



Coordination of inspections and/or certification;



Provide advisory services



RSOO can be funded directly or indirectly from Member States



Direct funding means annual contributions by States according to the agreed assessment scale



Indirect funding is provided through the budget of a regional organization, typically a regional economic community (REC), to which the RSOO is affiliated



RSOOs might also levy fees on the services they provide to States, such as licensing, certification, audits, inspections, training, technical assistance, and consultancy


1. RSOO Cooperative Platform (RSOO CP)

- facilitating the exchange of information and sharing of best practices,
- coordinating trainings, the development of handbooks and manuals;
- facilitating the exchange of data;
- facilitating the supply of technical assistance and support to and between RSOOs;
- interfacing with ICAO on topics of mutual interest for RSOOs;
- providing a pool of RSOO experts;
- supporting the development of relevant ICAO guidance material
- facilitate inter-RSOO communication and peer support

What is RRAP?


Major features of RSOO and RAIO Assessment Program (RRAP)

- Voluntary assessment programme of RSOOs and RAIOs, not an audit
- Using USOAP tools and methods, but modified
- \$ Cost-recovery
- Assesses qualifications and capabilities, not effective implementation
- Final result: assessment score, confidential
- Results of Assessments on RSOOs will increase RSOO credibility and support projects to help in closing gaps
- Current participants: ACSA, BAGASOO, PASO
- Future: CASSOA
